



In 2019, ENKA continued to undertake the Basra Umm Qasr Port quay wall and marine works and Dhi Qar and Samawa combined cycle power plants in Iraq, the combined cycle power plant in Nizhnekamsk, Tatarstan/Russia, the TAIF Business Centre in Kazan, Russia, construction and mechanical works on oil field in Kazakhstan and the mechanical, electrical and instrumentation installation works for FGP, 3GP also in Kazakhstan. In addition, work continued on the construction of US embassy building projects in various locations in Asia, Europe, Africa and North and South America.


The South Caucasus Pipeline Expansion Project in Georgia and the Crude Shipment Capacity Project in Tengiz, Kazakhstan were completed. Design, procurement, fabrication, construction and commissioning of the West Qurna 1 Initial Oil Train Project in Iraq has been completed and the mechanical completion of the 3rd Generation Injection Plant (3GI) Project in Tengiz has been achieved. The works were completed according to the original contract of the Pristina – Hani I Elezit Motorway project in Kosovo but the contract was extended until December 1, 2020 upon client's request with the construction of additional two intersections and one overpass.

In 2019, ENKA added to its current projects the construction of the 112 km Morava Corridor Motorway Project between Pojate to Prelijina in Serbia, the construction of a 250 MW capacity natural gas combined cycle power plant in Kazan, Tatarstan, the initial phase of high-technological multifunctional medical complex in St. Petersburg, Russia and the construction of a produced water treatment facility in Iraq.

Çimtaş continued its manufacturing activities in Turkey and China. In the field of power generation, ENKA's Electricity Sales Contract with the Electricity Generation Company (EÜAŞ) for the sale of power generated at the Gebze, Adapazarı and İzmir natural gas combined cycle plants that are wholly owned by ENKA and are operated within the framework of the Build-Operate model with a total installed capacity of 4,100 MW, ended in 2019. Following that, power generation has been suspended until further notice at the Gebze and Adapazarı plants in February 2019 and at the İzmir plant in August 2019.

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE AND COMMITTEES


There are three committees that serve under the Board of Directors of ENKA İnşaat ve Sanayi A.Ş. In addition, there are four committees and a work group under the Executive Committee which are active at various stages. Information regarding these units of governance at ENKA İnşaat ve Sanayi A.Ş. which are responsible for making decisions on economic, environmental and social impacts is given below.

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Corporate Governance Committee is to propose suggestions regarding the corporate governance of the company; to increase the quality of the corporate governance practices; to effectively monitor the regulations of the Capital Markets Board regarding corporate governance principles and any other corporate governance principles generally accepted on the international capital markets as well as to advise the Board of Directors on the implementation of any applicable ones thereof; to carry out necessary work for the nomination, assessment and training of suitable candidates for membership of the Board of Directors of the company, and for the determination of the principles of remuneration of the Members of the Board of Directors and top managers of the company and to propose suggestions to the Board on this issue.

EARLY IDENTIFICATION OF RISKS COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Committee that reports to the Board of Directors is the early identification of any potential risks that might jeopardise the existence, development and continuation of the company, the implementation of preventive actions concerning identified risks,



undertaking work related to risk management and reviewing risk management systems in force. The committee convenes at least once every two months, at least six times a year and acts jointly with the Risk Management Work Group.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Committee reporting to the Board of Directors is to ensure the due supervision of the independent audit of the accounting system and financial data of the company and the public disclosure of data, as well as the functioning and efficiency of the internal control system. The Audit Committee convenes at least once every 3 months and at least 4 times a year and reports the meeting results to the Board of Directors.

THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

Occupational Health and Safety Committee for ENKA's İstanbul Headquarters was formed as per the stipulations of Law 6331 on Occupational Health and Safety to assess potential risks to occupational health and safety (OHS), identify precautions and report to the Executive Committee. The committee meets every three months and consists of employer representative, OHS experts, the workplace doctor/nurse, the human resources expert, the administrative affairs officer, employee representatives and experts in field relevant to agenda items.

INFORMATION SECURITY COMMITTEE

Among the main roles and responsibilities of the Information Security Committee, which is structured to report to ENKA's President and Chairman of the Executive Committee; to identify information security risks related to the unit it is affiliated with, to ensure and encourage the implementation of policies and procedures within its units and the implementation of necessary monitoring and measurement activities within the company and its own units in order to achieve corporate information security targets, to recommend improvements related with information security management system. Committee meetings are organised every six months by the Information Security Administrator and the necessary work is undertaken for assessing the performance and effectiveness of the system and its continuous improvement.




ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE



ENKA'S TOTAL ASSETS ARE VALUED AT USD 8.3 BILLION. IN 2019, THE COMPANY GENERATED USD 1.9 BILLION REVENUE FROM THE 4 MAIN SECTORS IN WHICH IT IS ACTIVE AND ACHIEVED PROFITS WORTH USD 686 MILLION FOR ITS SHAREHOLDERS. 60.6% OF THE REVENUE WAS GENERATED FROM ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION, 18.3% FROM REAL ESTATE, 17.1% FROM ENERGY GENERATION, AND 6.3% FROM TRADE.² THE TOTAL REVENUE GENERATED FROM ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION SECTOR WAS USD 1.15 BILLION, WHILE ENKA'S SHARE OF THE NEW PROJECTS RECEIVED IN 2019 WAS USD 1.1 BILLION.

ENKA regularly pays its shareholders dividends from profits every year and plans to pay dividends in cash worth USD 273 million from its 2019 activities. In addition to the cash dividend, shares worth USD 25 million have been bought back, thus a total of USD 298 million would be paid to ENKA's shareholders.

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS IN 2019



ENKA İNŞAAT

- ENKA was ranked among the 50 strongest and most valuable brands of Turkey according to the 2019 report of the Brand Finance, international brand valuation consultancy.
- DA Build-Operate Agreement was signed with the Government of Georgia on April 25, 2019 within the scope of the development, construction, ownership and operation of the Namakhvani Cascade HEPP Project in Georgia, where 90% of it is owned by ENKA. The project consists of two separate hydroelectric power plants to be built on the River Rioni in Georgia, namely the Namakhvani HEPP (333 MW) and the Tvishi HEPP (100 MW) and a total investment of USD 750 million is projected.
- DENKA and its joint venture partner Bechtel have completed the construction of the Kosovo Motorway Route 6 Project, a 65 km four-lane motorway which stretches from Kosovo's capital, Pristina, to Northern Macedonia. The new route is now open to traffic, reducing travel time by half to 45 minutes. It constitutes an important part of Kosovo's national road network and it is expected to strengthen Kosovo's trade and relations with its neighbours and Western Europe.
- For the 3rd consecutive year, ENKA confirmed its status as a company with the best Safety Management System and received the mark of "Successful Safety Management" from the Russian Maritime Register of Shipping (RMRS) in St. Petersburg, Russia. ENKA remains to be the only company in Kazakhstan to receive a mark of distinction.

- ▶ The Third Generation Injection (3GI) Plant Project in Tengiz, Kazakhstan which has its contract signed on May 5, 2017 and started to be constructed in Tengiz, was successfully completed on April 30, 2019 without any lost time incident. The project achieved a total of 5,422,204 person-hours without a single lost time incident.
- Following evaluations of its environmental, social and governance practices, ENKA once again retained its place in the FTSE4Good Index of the London-based Financial Times Stock Exchange.
- According to the assessment completed by Borsa İstanbul in October 2019, ENKA has been entitled to be included in the BIST Sustainability Index that lists companies with high environmental, social and governance performance, with its corporate sustainability performance.
- DENKA, together with its joint venture partner Bechtel, have been selected by the Government of Republic of Serbia to undertake the design and construction works for the 112 km Morava Corridor Motorway Project which will connect central Serbia with Pan-European Corridors 10 and 11. The construction of the motorway will commence in early 2020 and each individual section of the motorway will be completed within 2.5 years with the total construction time of four years.



ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

- The scores for the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP), to which ENKA reported for the first time in 2018 in the Climate Change and Water Security categories, were announced in January 2019 and ENKA received a score of "B-".
- ENKA became a member of the Private Sector Volunteers Association (ÖSGD), which aims to increase the awareness of member companies and their employees about social problems, to develop the competencies of employees and to contribute to the work/ private life balance.
- DENKA supported the National Afforestation Day event organised by Ardahan Municipality and contributed to the transformation of this dry area into a green land that local community may benefit, by planting 400 spruce trees in

the area between the Kura River and the Walls of Ardahan Castle.

The Earth Hour which has been organised by the World Wildlife Fund for Nature (WWF) every year since 2007 in order to draw attention to global environmental issues and which is considered to be the world's largest environmental movement, was held on April 6th in Turkey this year. In addition to ENKA İnşaat, its subsidiaries ENKA Power, Çimtaş Group companies and ENKA Pazarlama participated "Earth Hour 2019" event by turning off the lights for one hour between 20:30 and 21:30. Besides, ENKA TC, MKH, OMKH, MOSENKA and CCI in Russia and Cimtas Ningbo in China participated this event which was carried out on March 30th worldwide.

ENKA GROUP COMPANIES

- Çimtaş Precision Machining renewed the National Aerospace and Defence Contractors Accreditation Program (NADCAP) certification in February 2019 for its shot peening process. Second audit of shot peening special process was completed with zero nonconformities, just as in the 2019 audit.
- Çimtaş Steel, a subsidiary of ENKA, was awarded its first off-shore component fabrication work, the Solitaire New Stinger Section project, by All Seas, a Dutch off-shore company, at the beginning of 2018 and started the project at the beginning of 2019. Within the scope of this project, the Stinger component which Çimtaş is responsible to manufacture will be used for installing marine pipelines of record weight for the purposes of the large oil and gas platforms in the Baltic Sea.
- D Cimtas Ningbo was awarded "Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design" certificate in "Gold" category (LEED Gold) by Bureau Veritas for the environment-friendly practices at its new manufacturing plant investment.
- The Longitudinal Submerged Arc Welding (LSAW) Steel Pipe Unit of Cimtas Pipe received a "five-star" rating for the excellence of its occupational health and safety practices, following a comprehensive audit conducted by the British Safety Council, one of the world's leading occupational health, safety and environment organisations.
- ▶ In mid-2019, Cimtas Pipe completed 10 million working hours (4.5 years) without a single work accident. As of the end of the year, it continues its operations with zero accidents.



ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

- As a part of sustainability practices, "Rainwater recycling project" was completed by ENKA TC. With the project launched at the end of 2019; rainwater was collected in a storage tank placed on the roof of Sevastopolsky Shopping Mall has been used in various areas within the shopping centre to save clean water resources.
- ▶ At the beginning of 2019, ENKA real estate companies; City Center Investment B.V. and ENKA TC started a waste separation project that includes their head office and common areas and they placed waste separation boxes in these areas for recycling purposes.
- **D** ENKA TC started to install recharging stations in the car parks of its shopping malls in Moscow where visitors can charge their electric cars free of charge.

- ▶ ENKA Schools Kocaeli completed the design works of the "Rainwater Recovery System" project which the school has initiated in the context of ENKA's sustainability goals in order to store rainwater and use the stored rainwater for watering the school garden.
- D With the support of the ENKA Sustainability Department, FIRST LEGO League team students from ENKA Schools istanbul completed the design phase of their project that makes use of solar power to charge rechargeable batteries and other rechargeable items and they developed a prototype in order to encourage the use of renewable energy and reduce battery waste.

Nork began in 2019 on a renewable energy project at ENKA Schools Kocaeli, planned in accordance with ENKA's sustainability goals. The project was initially designed by students from the school and it envisages the installation of solar panels on the roof of the school canteen so that the school can meet a significant part of its energy needs from solar energy.

- ▶ For the last 11 consecutive years, ENKA once again placed first in Turkey in the Construction International Contracting Sector category in the survey of "The Business World's Most Admired Companies" conducted by the business and economy magazine Capital. A total of 1,400 executives representing over 600 companies from a wide range of sectors took part in the survey, which the magazine has been conducting for the past 19 years.
- ENKA won the Engineering News-Record (ENR)
 Global Best Project Award for 2019 in the Retail/MixedUse Development category with its Kashirskaya Plaza
 Shopping and Entertainment Centre project in Moscow,
 Russia. The ENR awards are given for safe and innovative
 solutions to project design and construction challenges,
 international teamwork, contributions to the sector and
 the local community and the quality of the engineering
 and construction works.
- ▶ The West Qurna 1 Initial Oil Train (IOT) project which has been completed in Basra, Iraq, was found worthy of "Distinction" prize in the "International Safety Awards 2019" competition organised by British Safety Council.

ENKA SAILING

▶ ENKA Sailing Team won the İstanbul Sailing Club (IYK) trophy for the 6th time in a row. The trophy consists of six races and ENKA Sailing Team became the champion in IRC-0 division which is considered as the most prestigious yacht race category.

- ENKA Sailing Team regained the VELA Cup by winning the Bahçeşehir University Spring trophy, which was held for the third time in 2019 with four legs and a total of nine races.
- ▶ In the 20th Göcek Spring Race Week, ENKA Sailing Team came first in five of the six races in its group and won more races than any other team.

- Kashirskaya Plaza Shopping and Entertainment Centre project received the "Best Multifunctional Centre" award in the "Best Realised Project in the Field of Construction" competition organised by Moscow Municipality.
- Kashirskaya Plaza was named the "Best Large Shopping Centre" at the 2019 Commercial Real Estate Moscow Awards ceremony.
